

Conflict-Free Minerals Policy

Safety and the protection of people and the environment are fundamental principles of Inelteh company philosophy.

Recognising that risks of significant adverse impacts which may be associated with extracting, trading, handling and exporting minerals from conflict-affected and high-risk areas, and recognising that we have the responsibility to respect human rights and not contribute to conflict, we commit to adopt, widely disseminate and incorporate in contracts and/or agreements with suppliers the following policy on responsible sourcing of minerals from conflict-affected and high-risk areas.

We have committed ourselves to refuse products in which conflict materials are used and continuously working on to assure that all products that we use are conflict-free through all our product stages – from design, sourcing as well as production. We require that same commitment is followed by our sub suppliers.

Conflict Minerals are currently defined as tin, tungsten, tantalum and gold, also called as 3TG minerals.
